



## **Presentation of the A2DC**

The Foundation for Continental Law, in collaboration with the University Paris II Panthéon-Assas, brings together every summer young law practitioners from all over the world who spend a month acquiring knowledge of the Romano-Germanic legal culture by following Continental law course during the Summer University. The lectures are held at the University Paris II Panthéon-Assas by globally known professors.

The Association of Friends for Continental Law (A2DC) is an initiative led by some students dedicated to creating an association of former students of the Summer University, but not only. The goal of the Association is to help consolidate links between students and provide them with a network, suitable for professional exchange. In addition, the association gives the opportunity to interested students to publish comparative law scientific projects on its website (see link below) and it informs the members on these projects.

A map of the world that is also accessible on the site allows with a simple click to have an overview of the associated members in different continents and countries.

If you work as a lawyer on a cross-border case and you are wondering about how a foreign law regulates a particular issue, you can easily get information with the help of the Association of Friends for Continental Law who makes available this map of the world which brings together the jurists members of the association from all over the world. It is therefore easy for a member of the association to contact a foreign practitioner who is certainly willing to help a counterpart whatever his language is. It is also possible that the two practitioners know each other, having been part of the same promotion of the Summer University.

Ultimately, the Association of Friends for Continental Law offers its members the opportunity to easily and directly resolve international legal cases involving a preliminary examination of private international law, through the provision of legal advice on the law of the land in question.
